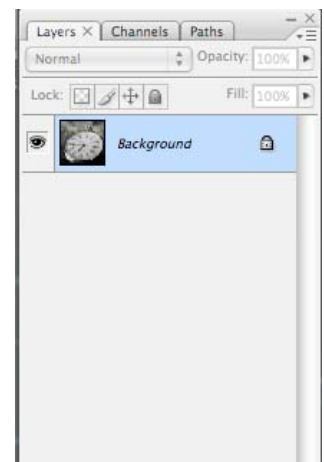
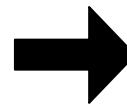
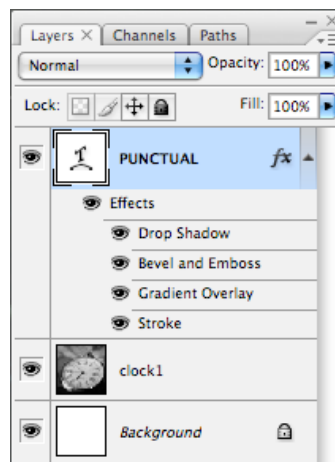
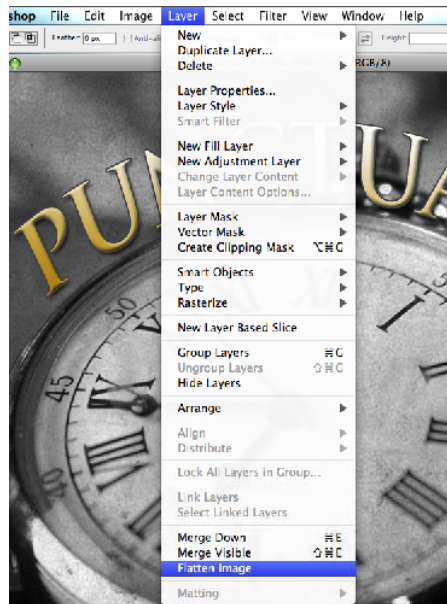


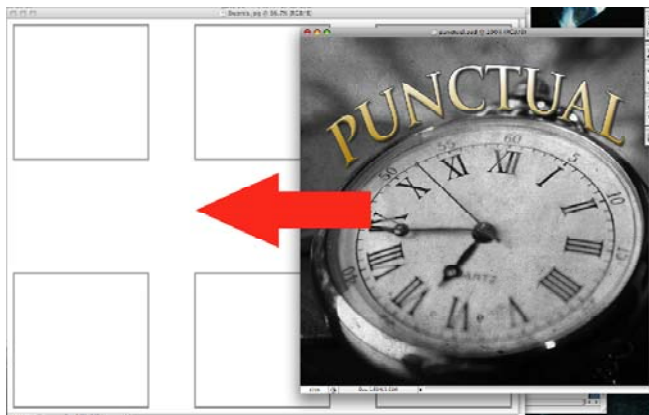
6 words Instructions Part 2

1. Download **layout** image from:
<http://diaz-arts.com/wp-content/uploads/2010/09/6words.jpg>
2. Open the image (**from the address above**) in Photoshop
3. Open your word 1 in Photoshop (Make sure your word is finished before you do this!)
4. Go to the top menu and click on: **Layer > Flatten Image**
This will combine all layers that make your image into one layer

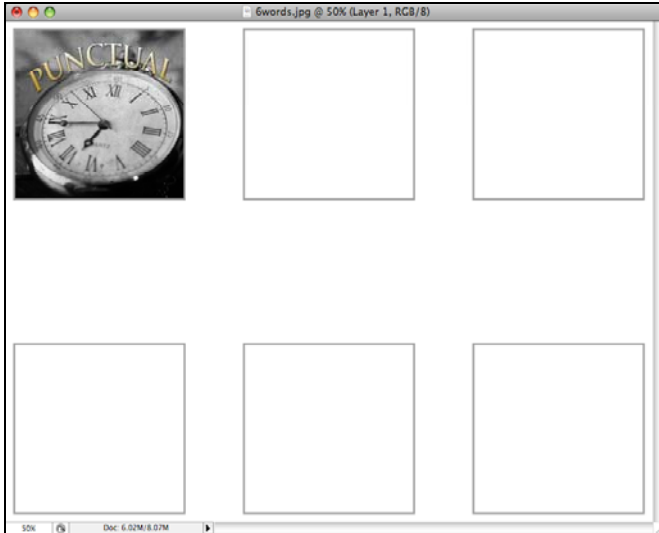

5. Click on the **Move Tool**
6. Drag your flattened word1 into the 6words.jpg layout file
Close word1 **without saving** it (so you can preserve the layers)



7. Go to the top menu and click on: **Edit > Free Transform**
Fit the word into one of the six boxes on the layout image.



8. Repeat with all six words.
9. Save file (with Photoshop format) in your projects folder.
